

Additional considerations discussed were: Establishing a 10-year forecast and a contingency plan, seeking a multi-year police services contract, looking at revitalization of the downtown to include the Police Station and Village Office relocated to Hwy 52.

Shannon Beamon arrived during the budget discussion at 6:21 pm.

10. Police Report – February, 2018: The police report detailed 93 traffic stops, 84 charges and 1 vehicle crash. Twenty-nine warning tickets were written. Mayor Herron met with Tony Tagliaferi from DOT. He looked at the plans for the speed signs and will report back.

11. Historic Gladstone Update: M. Edquist reported that the project is 75% complete with the carpentry being 95% complete. Paint color sample boards were available for review. Door hardware selection is in process. M. Edquist encouraged that we finish as originally planned rather than trying to incorporate anticipated up fits now that may be required later.

Mayor Herron called a Special Council meeting to be held, Thursday, Mar 15, 2018 at 1:00 pm for Council to review the Gladstone Building renovations and explore Gladstone budget priorities for Fiscal Year 18/19.
